


Regional distribution of conflicts and interventions across Africa in July 2023



Notes :

Northern Africa : In Tunisia, the row over migrants especially from sub-Saharan Africa continues despite various interventions.

Western Africa : Coup in Niger on 26th July increased the number of coups in the region, it also signalled increased rapprochements with Russia Wagner group.

Central Africa : Separatists attack on civilians in North West and South West Cameroun as well as militia attacks in Eastern DRC continued.

Eastern Africa : In Sudan, disagreement between Generals Hemedti and Al-Burhan worsened the situation, causing more casualties and displacements.

Southern Africa : This region continues as the most stable, except for fatal attacks in South Africa and on-going conflicts in Cabo Delgado Province of Mozambique.

5th July, 2023 : The Kofi Annan International Peacekeeping Training Centre (KAIPTC) has signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the United Nations Office to the African Union (UNOAU) to strengthen their collaboration and cooperation.

The MoU, which was signed in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia, will provide a framework for collaboration between the UNOAU and KAIPTC to support the African Union, its Regional and Economic Communities, Regional Mechanisms and Member States. It will further strengthen the UN-AU-KAIPTC partnership in the areas of contributing to addressing peace and security on the African continent.

The African Union Commission (AUC) and United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) launched the Africa Facility to Support Inclusive Transitions (AFSIT), on the side-lines of the 5th African Union Mid-Year Coordination Meeting, in Nairobi, Kenya, on 15 July 2023. AFSIT aims at providing support to countries undergoing complex political transitions and countries at risk.

In May 2023, African Union (AU) Heads of State and Government reiterated a zerotolerancestanceagainstunconstitutional changes of government (UCG) and called for collective action in developing a robust mechanism for deepening democracy and collective security on the continent. 

Mali asks UN to withdraw its peacekeeping mission « without delay »



The West African nation's military rulers criticised MINUSMA's «failure» to respond to security challenges.

Mali has called on the United Nations to withdraw its peacekeeping mission from the country "without delay," denouncing its "failure" to respond to security challenges.

Foreign Minister Abdoulaye Diop, who is part of Mali's interim military authorities, told a UN Security Council meeting on Friday that the peacekeeping force known as MINUSMA should withdraw its troops from the West African nation.

«It's a decision that the council has to make,» he told reporters. «But the point I'm making, and I believe it's a point that everyone agrees on, is that peacekeeping is based on the principle of consent from the host country and absent that consent, of course, operations are nearly impossible.»

Al Jazeera's Kristen Saloomey said that the mandate for the mission is due to expire at the end of the month ...



Strategic Reflection of The African Governance Platform on Strengthening Collaboration in Democracy, Governance and Promotion of Human Rights In Africa



On the occasion of the 10th Anniversary of the operationalization of African Governance Architecture (AGA), Members of the African Governance Platform (AGP) held a strategic reflection retreat from 9-11 July 2023 in Nairobi, Kenya on the margin of the African Union Mid-Year Coordination Meeting (MYCM).

The AGA was established in 2011 by an Assembly Decision as a **« a pan-African platform for dialogue between the various stakeholders »** mandated to promote good governance and strengthen democracy in Africa, in addition to translating the objectives of the legal and policy pronouncements stipulated in the African Union (AU) shared values instruments.

The strategic reflection retreat discussed the role of the African Governance Platform in promoting peace and security; as well as enhancing synergy and coordination amongst the African Union Commission, AUC, AU organs, Regional Economic Communities (RECs) and the Regional Mechanism (RMs). Discussions also reiterated the importance of setting the tone for the strategic direction and areas of collaboration and coordination over the next five years. The retreat informed the strategic direction of the Platform and identified ways to table the integration and good governance agenda at the MYCM of the Union ...
